How to Apply

To be considered for this award, please submit an application for your chosen programme through the University's online application portal.

You must have applied to the University for study in one of the outlined programmes by 18th January 2019; must be issued with an offer for your chosen programme by 15th February 2019; must hold a 3.7 CGPA or above; must be a US citizen and must identify as female.

- Friday 18 January 2019: Applications close for September 2019 entry
- Friday 22 March 2019: Decisions announced
